


Navajo Transit System FY14 Annual Ridership at 230,208

PROPOSED PROJECTS	Milestone	Probable Cost
1. Purchase bigger buses to serve the over capacity buses now serving the people. Bus price at \$600,000 each x ten buses equals \$6,000,000	September 2015	6,000,000
2. Coordinate with Bureau of Indian Affairs, Arizona DOT, New Mexico DOT, and Utah DOT on plans and construction of bus pullouts along highways. One pullout cost \$50,000 each (<i>Shelter Hardware in Storage</i>)	September 2015	1,500,000
3. Seek additional funding to fully complete the construction of the new Navajo Transit Administration/Maintenance Facility	September 2015	600,000
4. Installation of bus stop shelters along transit routes (25 shelters available now) \$20,000 each (met w/ AZDOT, NMDOT)	September 2015	500,000
5. Develop training plan for the staff to meet the mandatory training requirements (CPR; Customer Relations; Crisis Management)	September 2015	No external cost
6. Re-organize route schedule for efficiency and cost saving	September 2015	No external cost
7. Plan and Construct a Transit Bus Terminal in Window Rock	September 2016	1,500,000
8. Renovation of old Chinle Wool Warehouse for transit sub-station.	September 2015	700,000
9. Propose legislation for annual appreciation from Navajo Nation Fuel Excess Tax. Funding to be use as match-funding and transit improvement projects	September 2014	10 % of Fuel Excise Tax
