BID OPENING INFORMATION

The bid packages will be opened and reviewed by the Bid Evaluation Team on or by October 29, 2025. The selected companies will be notified by the Division of Aging and Long-Term Care Support, Program Supervisor II, Lesita T. Desiderio, by October 29, 2025.

The Navajo Nation is a sovereign government, and all contracts entered as a result of the RFP shall comply with all Navajo Nation laws, rules and regulations, including the Navajo Preference in Employment Act and Navajo Nation Procurement Rules and Regulations. The Navajo Nation will not waive its sovereignty status.

SCOPE OF SERVICES – Saint Michaels Senior Center:

Locations: St. Michael Senior Center sites is Hwy 264 South Crest Road Bldg #5000-22, St. Michels Chapter Compound, Saint Michaels, AZ 86511

The Division of Aging and Long-Term Care Support is seeking contractors(s) to complete Double Door Replacement and Removal of Exterior and Interior of the facility at **Saint Michael Senior Center**. There are (3) Exterior double doors, (3) Interior double doors and one Exterior single door.

The scope includes the following:

- Front doors, Steel Double Doors (Stainless) need to be replaced.
- (2) Back Doors, Steel single Door (Stainless) need to be replaced
- Garage doors, Double Doors (stainless) need to be replaced.
- Activity room (interior) wood double Doors (with door frames) need to be removed and replaced.
- Hallway, Dining Room entrance (Interior) double doors with wood frames need to be removed and replaced.
- Entrance Vestibules, wood double doors need to be replaced.

The scope includes the following:

- (1) Front doors, Steel Door (Stainless) need to be replaced.
- (2) side doors, Steel single Door (Stainless) need to be replaced

The Replacing and Removal of double doors will be restored to good condition, including all finishing work.

The Proposal for bid shall indicate the delivery dates of proposed services. Please include travel rates, personal expenses and other applicable fees. DALTCS fully expect the successful bidder to completely satisfy contract performance requirements.

Regarding Debarment, Suspension, and
Contracting Eligibility

1. Applicant entity acknowledges that to the best of its knowledge that the Applicant entity, either in its present form or in any identifiable capacity, has not, in accordance with 12 N.N.C. § 361:
 - A. Been convicted of the commission of criminal offenses incident to obtaining or attempting to obtain a public or private contract or subcontract, or in the performance of any such contract or subcontract;
 - B. Been convicted of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen property, or other offenses indicating a lack of business integrity or honesty, which currently, seriously, and directly affect responsibility as a Navajo Nation contractor;
 - C. Been convicted under antitrust statutes arising out of the submission of bids or proposals;
 - D. Violated contract provisions, including:
 - i. Deliberate failure, without good cause, to perform in accordance with the contract specifications or within the time limit provided in the contract,
 - ii. A recent record of failure to perform or of unsatisfactory performance with the terms of any contract, or
 - iii. Any other cause so serious and compelling as to affect responsibility as a Navajo Nation contractor, including debarment by another governmental entity.
2. Applicant acknowledges that if the Navajo Nation determines that the executed Certification provided herein is untrue or not wholly accurate, it shall be grounds for the Navajo Nation to terminate the contract and pursue other legal remedies, at the Navajo Nation's discretion.
3. Applicant certifies to the best of its knowledge that it is eligible to do business with the

Navajo Nation, in its present form or in any other identifiable capacity, pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 1501 and 5 N.N.C. § 301. Applicant also acknowledges that per 12 N.N.C. § 1505, it will not be eligible to contract with the Navajo Nation if deemed ineligible by the appropriate department or entity of the Navajo Nation which receives the Applicant's request for consideration for a business opportunity.
