2. Respondent Requirements

a. All respondents must have, at a minimum, the capabilities listed herein to perform the duties and responsibilities of the Scope of Work. Bids must reflect in detail the inclusion of these services and additional forms required. Respondents should also provide any

- technical information about the delivery of services required in the Request for Proposal (RFP).
- b. Vendors must demonstrate years of experience and a description working with youth and hosting sports events, including basketball camps. This may include credentials, including but not limited to licensures and certifications. All work performed must comply with required laws, safety codes and regulations.
- c. Vendors must have the ability to engage with a planning committee to finalize all event plans.
- d. This project is based on cost-reimbursement and therefore, vendors must demonstrate financial stability and have a process to submit all required documentation for the processing of reimbursement claims.

3. Proposal Format

- a. Appearance of the proposal must be professional and presentable.
- b. Not more than 20 pages, one-sided.
- c. Letter of Interest must be included.

4. Addendum

a. Any Addendum to this RFP will be submitted in writing to vendors who inquired about the RFP; and it will be posted on the Navajo Nation Office of the Controller's website and also on the Navajo Division for Children and Family Services' website.

5. Scope of Work

- a. The Navajo Division for Children and Family Services is requesting proposal and cost from qualified vendors to host a Basketball Skills Camp for school age children, ages ranging from 4 to 18.
- b. To host two Basketball Skills Camps.
- c. Assure that participants are enrolled and applicable information are collected about their age, contact information, emergency contacts, T-Shirt sizes, etc.
- d. Incorporate Navajo cultural teachings into the Basketball Skills Camp curriculum.
- e. Have hands-on basketball skills development stations.
- f. Each session to host up to 150 youth (Participants).
- g. Provide all necessary equipment to host the event: Registration, basketball camp, general assemblies, AV equipment, etc.
- h. Provide educational material or incentives for the participants such as T-shirts, socks, lanyard, backpacks, custom shorts, and/or hoodies. The incentives can be given as a standard incentive to all participants, or in increments of selected items based on accomplishments.

- Vendors must have ability to coordinate with the Coordinator and Planning Committee on cost, logistics, and participant accommodations.
- j. Vendors must comply with 2 CFR 200 Procurement Standards in identifying qualified, licensed contractors to provide minor home repair services.
- k. Identify two locations to host the event.
- 6. Funds Availability
 - a. The contract will be contingent upon availability of funds.
 - b. Vendors must have financial policies and procedures in compliance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.

All RFPs must be received by the NDCFS on or before August 19, 2025, at 3:00 PM (MST).

Regarding Debarment, Suspension, and **Contracting Eligibility**

- 1. Applicant entity acknowledges that to the best of its knowledge that the Applicant entity, either in its present form or in any identifiable capacity, has not, in accordance with 12 N.N.C. § 361:
 - A. Been convicted of the commission of criminal offenses incident to obtaining or attempting to obtain a public or private contract or subcontract, or in the performance of any such contract or subcontract;
 - B. Been convicted of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen property, or other offenses indicating a lack of business integrity or honesty, which currently, seriously, and directly affect responsibility as a Navajo Nation contractor;
 - C. Been convicted under antitrust statutes arising out of the submission of bids or proposals;
 - D. Violated contract provisions, including:
 - Deliberate failure, without good cause, to perform in accordance with the contract specifications or within the time limit provided in the contract,
 - ii. A recent record of failure to perform or of unsatisfactory performance with the terms of any contract, or
 - Any other cause so serious and compelling as to affect responsibility iii. as a Navajo Nation contractor, including debarment by another governmental entity.
- 2. Applicant acknowledges that if the Navajo Nation determines that the executed Certification provided herein is untrue or not wholly accurate, it shall be grounds for the Navajo Nation to terminate the contract and pursue other legal remedies, at the Navajo Nation's discretion.
- 3. Applicant certifies to the best of its knowledge that it is eligible to do business with the

Navajo Nation, in its present form or in any other identifiable capacity, pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 1501 and 5 N.N.C. § 301. Applicant also acknowledges that per 12 N.N.C. § 1505, it will not be eligible to contract with the Navajo Nation if deemed ineligible by the appropriate department or entity of the Navajo Nation which receives the Applicant's request for consideration for a business opportunity.
