INVITATION: Colorado Ranch Enterprise payroll services, ranch management and marketing services.

The Navajo Nation Department of Fish and Wildlife (NNDFWL) is requesting proposals from qualified contractors to manage payroll processing and ranch management services for the Colorado Ranch Enterprise. This Request for Proposal (RFP) outlines the requirements and expectations for the services to be provided.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES FOR THIS RFP

RESPONDENT REQUIREMENTS

- 1. All respondents must have the capabilities listed herein, including sufficient detailed information with regard to experience and expertise in meeting the following requirements:
 - a. Legitimate and credible experience and history providing the described services with a minimum of five (5) years. Must have provided payroll, ranch management and marketing services to the Navajo Nation in the past.
 - b. The Navajo Business Opportunity Act (5 N.N.C. §§ 201 and 215), the Navajo Business and Procurement Act (12 N.N.C. §§ 1501-1516), Navajo Nation Procurement Code (12 N.N.C. §§ 301-371), and the Navajo Preference in Employment Act (15 N.N.C. §§ 601 et seq.), with all implementing regulations, will apply.
 - c. Working knowledge of the Navajo Nation Wolf Spring & Boyer Ranch Management under the Colorado Ranch Enterprise (Resolution No: BFJA-02-18)
 - d. Proficient knowledge of Federal and Colorado employment laws and withholdings for employees.

2. Insurance.

a. The selected entity, upon receiving authorization to proceed, Consultant shall procure and maintain, during the life of this contract, Workers Compensation, and Professional Liability Insurance policies including Errors and Omission Insurance.

Workers Compensation Statutory Coverage: Employers Liability coverage with minimum limits of \$1,000,000/\$1,000,000/\$1,000,000

Professional Liability: \$1,000,000 Each Occurrence, \$2,000,000 aggregate

The Navajo Nation shall be named as additional insured for general liability coverage.

All coverages should include a waiver of subrogation. All coverages should be primary and the Navajo Nation's coverage non-contributory.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The Department of Fish and Wildlife, Colorado Ranch Enterprise has Management oversight of Wolf Springs and Boyer Ranches in Westcliffe, Colorado. The Fish and Wildlife Department Manager Ill/Ranch General Manager will ensure the Colorado Ranch Enterprise's Fiscal Year 2026 Annual and Master Plans are achieved. The contractor will employ 4 full-time and 1 part-time employee for the contract period (October 1, 2025 to September 30, 2026). The contractor shall use the employment standards of practice for the State of Colorado and will be responsible for paying bi-weekly wages to employees, medical (for full-time employees), dental (for full-time employees), Unemployment, and Workmen's Compensation. In addition, the contractor will pay taxes, FICA/Medicare Match and process bi-weekly Withholdings, CO/FAMLI, Quarterlies, Year-End Reports & W-2's.

The services provided will include: hirings and firing of employees, daily work with the livestock, Navajo Nation owned large tractors and farm equipment and infrastructure maintenance, hay production and ranch operations. Assist in writing a ranch management plan and establish a pilot retail market for Direct-to-consumer meat sales along with researching other potential purchase competitors of livestock. Upon request and when necessary, the contractor will draw up any necessary documents requested by the Navajo Nation Fish and Wildlife Department Manager III/Ranch General Manager to create sales activity and marketing reports.

4. PROPOSAL CONTENT AND REQUIRED INFORMATION

- 4. Deliverables
- 5. Schedule, including proposed site visits.
- 6. Copies of licenses, certifications (NBOA Priority Status), insurance certificates, and other relevant documents.
- 7. Costs to be submitted in a separate sealed envelope. Detailed breakdown of personnel, fringe benefits other applicable costs; 6% Navajo Nation Sales Tax, if applicable.
- 8. Compliance: Any proposal that does not adhere to this format and does not address each specification, requirement, or scope of work as outlined, may be deemed non-responsive and rejected on that basis.

5. EVALUATION PROCESS (pre-qualifying process)

1. Evaluation Criteria

- a. Qualifications, credentials, and minimum five (5) years' work experience. This includes the capabilities to provide all requested services.
- b. Quality of products, ability to provide requested work products, scope of work, deliverables, and marketing services.
- c. Project schedule: payroll, personnel responsibilities and visits to the ranch with time frame.
- d. Cost (separate sealed envelope).

The Navajo Nation is a sovereign government and all contracts entered into as a result of this RFP shall comply with Navajo Nation Law, rules and regulations, including the Navajo Preference in Employment Act, and applicable federal; laws, rules and regulations.

The payment procedures established by the Division of Finance shall be adhered to and are to begin whenever goods are delivered and accepted.

Bid shall be effective on the date of award.

It is the responsibility of the offeror to identify themselves as certified under the Navajo Nation Business Opportunity Act.

The Bid will open on **November 3, 2025** and close on **November 11, 2025** at 5 pm Mountain Time. RFP's received after the specified time will not be accepted. After BIDs are received, the BIDs will be reviewed by the BID TEAM **On November 12, 2025** and a selection will be made. The selected vendor will be notified by Navajo Fish and Wildlife staff.

Regarding Debarment, Suspension, and Contracting Eligibility

- 1. Applicant entity acknowledges that to the best of its knowledge that the Applicant entity, either in its present form or in any identifiable capacity, has not, in accordance with 12 N.N.C. § 361:
 - A. Been convicted of the commission of criminal offenses incident to obtaining or attempting to obtain a public or private contract or subcontract, or in the performance of any such contract or subcontract;
 - B. Been convicted of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen property, or other offenses indicating a lack of business integrity or honesty, which currently, seriously, and directly affect responsibility as a Navajo Nation contractor;
 - C. Been convicted under antitrust statutes arising out of the submission of bids or proposals;
 - D. Violated contract provisions, including:
 - i. Deliberate failure, without good cause, to perform in accordance with the contract specifications or within the time limit provided in the contract.
 - ii. A recent record of failure to perform or of unsatisfactory performance with the terms of any contract, or
 - iii. Any other cause so serious and compelling as to affect responsibility as a Navajo Nation contractor, including debarment by another governmental entity.
- 2. Applicant acknowledges that if the Navajo Nation determines that the executed Certification provided herein is untrue or not wholly accurate, it shall be grounds for the Navajo Nation to terminate the contract and pursue other legal remedies, at the Navajo Nation's discretion.
- 3. Applicant certifies to the best of its knowledge that it is eligible to do business with the

Navajo Nation, in its present form or in any other identifiable capacity, pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 1501 and 5 N.N.C. § 301. Applicant also acknowledges that per 12 N.N.C. § 1505, it will not be eligible to contract with the Navajo Nation if deemed ineligible by the appropriate department or entity of the Navajo Nation which receives the Applicant's request for consideration for a business opportunity.
