#### **PURPOSE OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS**

The Navajo Natural Heritage Program under the Navajo Nation Department of Fish and Wildlife, hereafter referred to as the Navajo Natural Heritage program or NNHP, is requesting proposals for the purchase of an approximately 1,250-1,500 SF, energy efficient, prefabricated greenhouse with associated equipment and services. Potential offerors are encouraged to review this Request for Proposals (RFP) for details and mandatory requirements.

#### **RFP SEQUENCE OF EVENTS**

- 1. **Issue RFP December 12, 2025** This RFP is issued by the Project Manager on behalf of NNHP, in accordance with Navajo Nation Laws. NNHP is the only organization that is authorized to make copies or distribute this RFP.
- Submission of Proposal 5:00 p.m. MST on December 22, 2025. Proposals received after this deadline will not be accepted. Proposals must be submitted through email to frontdesk@nndfw.org , with the subject line: "DO NOT OPEN Bid No. 25-12-3948DB PREFABRICATED GREENHOUSE PURCHASE"
- 3. Proposal Evaluation December 23, 2025
- 4. Notice of Award December 23, 2025
- 5. **Contract Negotiation** The Project Manager, and the successful Offeror will begin contract negotiations with the highest ranked firm as soon as possible after notice of award. Actual fees shall be negotiated based upon specific scope of services, and reimbursable, specific contractor requirements.

## **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Protests – Any offeror who is aggrieved in connection with the award of a contract must first resolve their protest with NNHP. If no resolution is obtained, the offeror may protest to the Navajo Nation's Business Regulatory Department. The protest must be submitted in writing within fifteen (15) calendar days after knowledge of the facts or occurrences giving rise to the

protest to: Navajo Business Regulatory Department; P.O. Box 663; Window Rock, Arizona 86515; Phone number: (928) 357-6643.

- Protests must include the name and address of the protestant, the solicitation number, and a statement of grounds for protest, including appropriate supporting exhibits. Protests received after the deadline will not be accepted.
- 3. Incurring Cost Any cost incurred by the offeror in preparation, transmittal, or presentation of any proposal or material submitted in response to this RFP shall be borne solely by the offeror.
- 4. Amended Proposals An offeror may submit an amended proposal before the deadline for receipt of proposals. Such amended proposals must be the complete replacements for a previously submitted proposal and must be clearly identified as such in the transmittal letter. The Project Manager will not collate or assemble proposal materials.
- 5. NNHP reserves the right to reject an offer from any offeror who has previously failed to perform properly, has caused the Department to incur unreasonable costs or expense, failed to complete on time an agreement of a similar nature, or who is not in a position to perform the work governed by this RFP.
- 6. Offerors Right to Withdraw Proposal Offerors will be allowed to withdraw their proposals at any time, prior to the deadline for receipt of proposals.
- 7. Disclosure of Proposal Contents The content of proposals will be kept confidential until the Project Manager has issued the written notice of a contract award. At that time, all proposals will be opened to the public, except for the material, which has been previously noted and deemed as proprietary or confidential.
- 8. Termination This RFP may be canceled at any time and any and all proposals may be rejected in whole or in part when the Project Manager determines such action to be in the best interest of the Navajo Natural Heritage Program.
- 9. Sufficient Appropriation Any contract awarded as a result of this RFP process may be terminated if insufficient appropriations or authorizations do not exist. Sending written notice to the consultant will affect such termination. The Owner's decision as to whether sufficient appropriations and authorization are available is in the sole discretion of the Owner and shall be final and binding upon the contractor. If the determination is made that there is insufficient funding to continue or finalize a project, the consultant will be compensated to the level of effort performed, as authorized by the Project Manager prior to that determination.
- 10. Offeror Qualifications The Selection Committee may make such investigations as necessary to determine the ability of the offeror to adhere to the requirements specified within this RFP. The Selection Committee will reject the proposal of any offeror who is not a responsible offeror and fails to submit a responsive offer.
- 11. Right to Waive Minor Irregularities The Selection Committee reserves the right to waive minor irregularities. The Selection Committee also reserves the right to waive mandatory requirements provided that all of the otherwise responsive proposals fail to meet the same mandatory

requirements and the failure to do so does not otherwise materially affect the procurement. This right is at the sole discretion of the Selection Committee.

- 12. Notice The Navajo Nation Ethics in Government Law imposes penalties for bribes, gratuities and kickbacks.
- 13. Release of Information Only the Project Manager is authorized to release information about the project covered by this RFP. The Offerors must refer to the owner any request to release any information that pertains to the work or activities covered by any action or award related to this RFP.
- 14. Applicable Laws The laws of the Navajo Nation shall govern this procurement and any agreement that may result from this procurement with applicable provisions from State and Federal Laws.

#### **DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF GOODS REQUESTED**

NNHP is seeking to purchase an approximately 1,250-1,500 SF, energy efficient, prefabricated greenhouse with associated equipment and services. The greenhouse will be attached to the existing Diné Native Plants Program seed bank building in Window Rock, AZ. The greenhouse needs to meet the following requirements:

- 1. The design of the greenhouse needs to be mono-pitched and designed to be attached to an existing CMU wall.
- 2. Steel frame, with 16mm polycarbonate walls.
- 3. Structure dimensions approximately 25' wide x 60' long and no taller than 15' at its peak.
- 4. Include an evaporative cooling system and airflow vents.
- 5. Include a heating system.
- 6. Include an automated shade cloth system.
- 7. Include grow benches.
- 8. Include design/engineering specification of a concrete foundation for the greenhouse to be constructed on.
- 9. Include construction support for assembly of the greenhouse.

#### MANDATORY SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

- Submittal Letter Proposals must be accompanied by a submittal letter that must:
  - Identify the submitting business. State the name and address of the organization's firm or office. Indicate organizational structure (individual, partnership or public, profit or nonprofit).
  - 2. Identify the name and title of the person(s) authorized by the company to contractually obligate the business for the purpose of this RFP;
  - 3. Explicitly indicate acceptance of the General Terms and Conditions; Be executed (signed) by a person authorized to contractually obligate the offeror;
  - 4. Contain a statement indicating a commitment to comply and act in accordance with the requirements of the Build America, Buy America provisions of the Federal Bipartisan

- Infrastructure Law.
- 5. Certify to the best of their knowledge and belief that the offeror, the firm, or any of its principals are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, or declared ineligible for the award of contracts by any federal agency or Indian tribe. The offeror will also certify they have not, within a three-year period preceding this RFP, been convicted of or had a civil judgment rendered against them for:
  - Commission of fraud or a criminal offense in connection with obtaining, attempting to obtain, or performing a public (federal, state, local or tribal) contract or subcontract;
  - Violation of federal or state antitrust statutes relating to the submission of offers;
  - Commission of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsifications or destruction of records, making false statements, and are not presently indicted for, or otherwise criminally or civilly charged by a governmental entity with, commission of any of the offenses enumerated in this provision.
  - The offeror certifies they have not, within a three-year period preceding this RFP, had one or more contracts terminated for default by a federal, state, local or tribal agency.

#### **EVALUATION**

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria. A maximum of 100 points is possible, only proposals scoring 75 or higher will be considered for selection.

- 1. **Greenhouse Specifications**: Demonstrates the product specifications meet the requirements outlined in the RFP, including greenhouse dimensions, attachable design, climate control, etc. **25 points**
- Foundation Design/Engineering: Demonstrates the purchase of the prefabricated greenhouse includes the design/engineering of the concrete foundation on which the greenhouse will be constructed. – 25 points
- 3. **Construction Support**: Demonstrates the offeror will provide support through detailed instructions and/or in-person consultation for the construction of the greenhouse. **25 points**
- 4. **Cost Estimate**: Estimated overall cost meets the allocated budget for the project. **25 points**
