The chapter needs a reliable working vehicle to pull heavy payload, haul John Deere Backhoe tractor, and haul hay for livestock.

The chapter request an F350 Ford truck, 4WD Dually, Gooseneck towing package, 7.3L Gasoline fuel system or equivalent diesel engine, to enable the transportation of heavy load and to provide heavy-duty service for the chapter.

Terms and Conditions

1. Bidders must be an Authorized Fully Certified Automotive Dealership who meets all standards and qualifications from the Automotive Manufacture. Vehicle is to be delivered in a timely fashion as the bid evaluation shall be based on who is most responsive in compliance with specification and criteria.

- a. Bid price shall FOB (Freight on Board) to which delivery is made to the Navajo Nation Fleet Management, Window Rock, Arizona 86033.
- b. Vehicles will be delivered to the Navajo Nation Free from any purchase money, Liens, or Security Interest.

- c. The manufacturers published warranty for the vehicle shall apply to All Vehicles purchased by the Navajo Nation Fleet management/Chilchinbeto Chapter of the Navajo Nation
2. The bid price shall be effective on the date of award, and the availability of funds will determine the number of vehicles to purchase, and additional procurement for like-kind and quality of vehicle also qualified for bid price.
3. The Chilchinbeto Chapter/Navajo Nation will receive, at time of delivery of vehicles, all pertinent documents necessary for titling and licensing vehicles, including Manufacturer's Statement of Origin, Odometer statement, etc.
- a. Only the Navajo Nation Fleet Management will be registering each vehicle through the Navajo Nation Property Management Department. Payment will be made after delivery of the vehicles and receipt of all pertinent documents, including invoice. Full payment is to made not later than 30 working days following receipt of all pertinent documents, including invoice. Temporary license sticker must accompany upon delivery if no release of Manufacture Statement of Original is included as part of the documents and will delay timely payment.
4. It is the Chilchinbeto Chapter's intention to award the Bid to the lowest Responsible Bidder who meets all criteria of bid.
5. Submission of all bids are to include: one original and two (2) copies, be enclosed in one seal envelope.
- a. Respondent's Name and contact information, ITB Bid Number: (25-12-3958DB), The Chilchinbeto Chapter, a 2025 F350 Ford Truck, 4WD, Dually,
- b. Any sealed bid received after the closing date and time will not be accepted and will be returned to the sender. Faxed or emailed proposal/bids will not be accepted.
- d. The Chilchinbeto Chapter and the Navajo Nation shall reserve the right to reject any or all bids or increase or decrease quantity of price.
6. Certified Navajo Business - Must provide proof that business is currently certified by the Navajo Nation-Business Regulatory Department and prioritized under Navajo Nation Council Resolution CAP-37-02 and under the Section 204 (A) (1) and (2) of the revised Navajo Nation Business Opportunity Act.
7. Taxes - All performance under this Contract within the territorial jurisdiction of Navajo Nation is subject to the six percent (6 %) Navajo Sales Tax (24 N.N.C. 601 et seq.).
8. Nothing in the ITB is intended to or shall have the effect of waiving any privileges or immunities afforded. The Navajo Nation including, but not limited to, Sovereign immunity or official immunity, and it is Expressly agreed that the Navajo Nation retains such privileges.
9. The Navajo Nation is a sovereign government and all contracts entered because of the ITB shall comply with the Navajo Nation Laws, rules, and regulations, Navajo Business Opportunity Act, and applicable federal law, rules and regulations.

1. Applicant acknowledges, in accordance with the Navajo Nation Procurement Act, 12 N.N.C. §§ 301-80, to the best of its knowledge, Applicant, in either its present form or in any other identifiable capacity, that it has not:
 - a. been convicted in any jurisdiction for the commission of a criminal offense incident to obtaining, or attempting to obtain, a public or private contract or subcontract, or in the performance of such Contract or subcontract;
 - b. been convicted in any jurisdiction for embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen property, or any other offense indicating a lack of business integrity or business honesty which currently, seriously, and directly affects responsibility as a Navajo Nation Contractor;
 - c. been convicted in any jurisdiction under any antitrust statute arising out of the submission of offers;
 - d. violated contract provisions, such as having:
 - i. deliberately failed, without good cause, to perform in accordance with the purchase description or within the time limit provided in the contract; or
 - ii. a record of failure to perform, or of unsatisfactory performance, with the terms of one or more contracts; or
 - e. been determined to be ineligible to conduct business with the Navajo Nation under the Navajo Business Opportunity Act, 12 N.N.C. §§ 201-380;
 - f. submitted bad offers where such offers are lower than the expected price, or overstate the Applicant's qualifications; and
 - g. engaged in any other cause so serious and compelling as to affect Applicant's responsibility as a Navajo Nation Contractor, including debarment or suspension by another government.
2. Applicant certifies that the individual named below is authorized to represent Applicant for purposes of the declarations in this certification, and that all such declarations are made on behalf of Applicant and all of its owners, partners, officers, members, employees, officials, agents, or parties-in-interest;
3. Applicant acknowledges that, if the Navajo Nation determines this executed Certification is untrue or not wholly accurate, the Navajo Nation shall have grounds terminate the contract award or contract and pursue other legal remedies, at the Navajo Nation's discretion.
4. Applicant certifies that, to the best of its knowledge, it is eligible to do business with the Navajo Nation, in its present form or in any other identifiable capacity, pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §§ 1501-16 and 5 N.N.C. §§ 201-380.
5. Applicant acknowledges that per 12 N.N.C. § 1505, it will not be eligible to contract with the Navajo Nation if deemed ineligible by the appropriate department or entity of the Navajo Nation which receives the Applicant's request for consideration for a business opportunity.
